Who are the programmes for:

Ex- offenders: This programme is available to any exoffenders who:

Are not in employment.

Live in Milton Keynes, Aylesbury Vale or Cherwell Areas.

NEETS: This programme is available for:

A young person who is aged between 15 and 24 and are Not in Education, Employment or Training.

Live in the Aylesbury Vale or Cherwell Areas.

Physical Health Issues: This programme is available to adult who:

Are not in employment.
